

## PROCESSING OF CONTRACTORS' BENEFICIAL OWNERS' PERSONAL DATA RELATED TO PROCUREMENT IN REPOWER-CEST PROJECT

<b>Purpose and legal grounds for processing of personal data</b>	Procurement in REPower-CEST project are funded by the European Union Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF). We collect data of beneficial owners on procurements that are funded with RRF funding on behalf of the granting authority (Finnish Environment Institute) that uses the data for reporting, auditing and monitoring the use of funds. The basis for processing the personal data is the performance of controller's tasks carried out in public interest (Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR and Section 4 of the Data Protection Act): the data in question describes a person's position in business life or similar activities, the purpose of the processing is in the public interest and the processing is proportionate to the legitimate purpose pursued.
<b>Data content</b>	
<b>Data content of the register and categories of personal data</b>	The personal data collected includes: The contractors' beneficial owners: - First and last name - Date of birth

<b>Sources of data</b>	<p>The Finnish Environmental Institute (Syke) collects the personal data of beneficial owners that are Finnish companies and have Finnish business IDs from the Trade Register of National Board of Patents and Registration.</p> <p>The personal data of beneficial owners that have no Finnish business IDs or are foreign companies are collected direct from the contractors. If for some other reason the personal data of beneficial owners is not available in the Trade Register of National Board of Patents and Registration the personal data is also collected directly.</p>
<b>Storage period for personal data</b>	<p>Personal data is retained for the necessary duration for GTK to fulfill the purposes described in this notice. The data will be deleted immediately after the purpose ceases to exist.</p>
<b>Data processing</b>	
<b>Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data (To whom data may be disclosed)</b>	<p>Those involved in reporting the personal data of beneficial owners for GTK's REPower-CEST project.</p> <p>GTK transfers the data to the granting authority (the Finnish Environmental institute) that processes the data to comply with its statutory duty.</p> <p>The Finnish Environmental Institution is responsible for transmitting the data to RRP system that the State Treasury administers.</p>
<b>Transfer of personal data to third countries outside the EU/EEA</b>	<p>Personal data is not transferred or disclosed outside the EU or EEA.</p>
<b>Automated decision-making and profiling</b>	<p>No decisions based on automated decision-making or profiling are made based on the collected personal data.</p>
<b>Rights of the data subject</b>	
<b>Exercise of rights</b>	<p>The data subject may exercise their rights by submitting a request to this effect to the data controller (Geological Survey of Finland) at the</p>

	<p>address mentioned above under 'Data Controller'. To expedite the processing of the request, we ask that you mention the register to which the request relates.</p>
<p><b>Right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority</b></p>	<p>If the data subject considers the processing of their personal data to be incompatible with the law, they may lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.</p> <p>In Finland, the case can be referred to the Office of the Data Protection Ombudsman.  <a href="#">Contact information   Data Protection Ombudsman's Office (tietosuoja.fi)</a></p>
<p><b>Right to access personal data</b></p>	<p>The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation from the controller that their personal data are being processed or are not being processed, and if this personal data is being processed, the right to access the personal data.</p>
<p><b>Right to have data rectified</b></p>	<p>The data subject has the right to demand that the controller without undue delay corrects inaccurate or incorrect personal data concerning the data subject.</p>
<p><b>Right to restrict processing</b></p>	<p>The data subject has the right to request the controller to restrict the processing of their personal data if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the data subject contests the accuracy of their personal data.</li> <li>- the processing of personal data is unlawful, but the data subject opposes the erasure of their personal data and instead requests the restriction of their use.</li> <li>- the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but the data subject needs them for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.</li> <li>- the data subject has objected to the processing of his or her personal data pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject.</li> </ul>

<b>Right to object</b>	The data subject may object to the processing of the data on grounds relating to their particular situation. In such case the controller must stop processing the data unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or the processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.
